

Will your post exist in the 22nd Century?

Do you aggressively recruit new members? Do you aggressively seek to regain former members? Do you aggressively seek to retain your current members?

If you didn't answer yes to all three of the questions, your post will shrivel and fade away, just like an old soldier!

So, what do I mean by aggressively?

Have you ever requested a roster of all the unpaid relocated members and unpaid members from Department? Depending on where your post is, there may not be very many, but even one or two recruitments can make a difference.

Do you ever visit past members of your post and try to get them to sign back up? Even those whose membership lapsed 5, 10, or even 15 years ago? I have been contacting comrades whose dues lapsed as far back as 2001 and signing them back up. They are just as willing to rejoin as members whose dues lapsed only two or three years ago!

Do you conduct an annual membership drive in Jan/Feb where you at least call and preferably visit, your unpaid members?


