



Online Membership System.

I have frequently had a quartermaster or other post member tell me they are trying to straighten out their post membership roster because the Online Membership System is incorrect. Quote, "We have paid members not on our online roster."

As a Post Quartermaster myself, and one who has repeatedly emailed and called the National Membership Department, I can tell you what is online is what is correct!

Why is "John Smith" not on our roster? — a. National was notified directly by "other means" (usually a family member) that the member passed. No notification or online history is available to the post quartermaster. b. The member transferred to another post. c. The dues were NOT paid online and were not received at National.

They show members in our post I don't have on my local roster. Answer. QM failed to add the member to his local copy of the roster when member transferred in. (When you process a bunch of renewals and transfers in one session, it is easy to miss a step!



AN IMPORTANT SCAM NOTIFICATION FROM USAA

SOCIAL MEDIA SCAM TARGETING SERVICE MEMBERS

DO NOT provide your personal banking information through social media.

There is a social media scam, predominately seen in Instagram, which is targeting military service members. This scam has been around for over a year, but has picked up steam over the past few months and more and more people in and out of the military are falling prey to fraudsters.

The fraudsters are targeting military, veterans and their families. In exchange for their personal banking information, they are promised the ability to make easy money. The victim provides their log in/password information and the fraudster gains the ability to deposit fraudulent funds directly into their account. They immediately pull out their fee, before the institution can identify the credibility of the deposit, and the victim is left responsible for the used funds. The amounts range from \$2K to \$20K, growing the debt of the victims in a matter of minutes.


