Are you helping your Auxiliary?

Many posts no longer have an Auxiliary. Some posts don't seem to get along with this important partner. Most posts complain about their lack of "manpower" to work our programs such as poppies. Many of the Auxiliaries we have are hurting for members as bad or even worse than the post they are affiliated with.

Everyone knows this, but few do anything about it.

My post recently chartered an Auxiliary. Here is just a quick list of what we are doing for them in return for all we ask of them:

- 1. When we recruit a new/reinstated/ transfer member into our post, we obtain the spouses name and ask if our Auxiliary can contact them. If yes, we get their phone number as well!
- We ensure the Auxiliary President and Treasurer are provided the means (\$) to attend Department meetings if their spouse is not already being paid by the post.
- 3. We share the proceeds of money makers based on man-hours worked.
- We think a head and coordinate our requests of them two meetings in advance.

It took me about 18 months and several dozen hours of work to obtain the required # of applications to form and charter an Auxiliary. But, they are well worth the effort and not just for helping out with programs and events. Our younger veterans want family oriented activities. Getting spouses and older children involved is one of the keys to retaining active members.






### **ROTC Awards in Lincoln**
