**POST ALL-STATE TEAM:** Award is given to the top twenty (20) Post Commanders and Quartermasters based on requirements found on page 3 of this manual. Posts will be ranked based on the completion of mandatory requirements and any additional points earned. Each All-State Post Commander and Quartermaster will receive a certificate and All-State Overseas Cover recognizing the accomplishments of the Post along with ten (10) All-State Team Post Member pins for Post membership. Additional pins are available for purchase by contacting Department Headquarters.

**POST ALL-STATE CAPTAIN:** Award is given to the first place Post Commander and Quartermaster based on the completion of the mandatory requirements and highest additional points earned. In addition to the Post All-State Team awards listed above, the First Place Commander and Quartermaster will receive an additional designation of "Captain" on their Overseas Cover and will receive **\$599.00** each to help defray the costs of attending the upcoming National Convention. \*\* Monetary Award cannot be combined with a National Appointment stipend to attend the National Convention \*\*

**CHARLES G. KLINGMAN MEMORIAL AWARD:** Award is given to the BEST OVERALL POST as selected by the Department Commander. Items to be considered but are not limited to <a href="Membership">Membership</a>, <a href="Program Reporting">Program Reporting</a>, <a href="Quite output color: 100% output colo

**CLIFF POLK MEMBERSHIP MEMORIAL AWARD:** Award is given to the Post which achieves the greatest numerical membership increase from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Recipients will receive a plaque of distinction.

**JOHN R. LIEBSACK LEGACY AWARD:** Award is given to the top three (3) Posts that achieve, on or before June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024, a 10%+ increase in Life members from the previous year (Minimum of five (5) new Life Members). Recipients will receive a plaque of distinction and **\$200.00** stipend to help defray the costs of attending an upcoming VFW meeting (Homecoming/Fall Council or Mid-Winter Conference).

**DISTRICT ALL-STATE TEAM:** Award is given to ANY District Commander who meets the All-State requirements found on page 7 of this manual. Districts will be ranked based on the completion of mandatory requirements, additional White Hat requirements and any additional points earned. Each All-State District Commander will receive a certificate and All-State Overseas Cover recognizing their accomplishments.

**DISTRICT ALL-STATE CAPTAIN:** Award is given to the first place District Commander based on the completion of the mandatory requirements and highest additional points earned. In addition to the District All-State awards listed above, the First Place District Commander will receive an additional designation of "Captain" on their Overseas Cover and will receive **\$599.00** to help defray the costs of attending the upcoming National Convention. \*\* Monetary Award cannot be combined with a National Appointment stipend to attend the National Convention \*\*

#### MEMBERSHIP RECRUITMENT INCENTIVES

POST LEVEL INCENTIVES

**LIFE INCENTIVE PROGRAM (Part 1):** The Department has allocated \$3500.00 and will pay up to \$50.00 toward any members new/unpaid upgrade/reinstate to convert current or prospective members to joining as a Life Member. *Installment Plans exempt from eligibility.* 

**LIFE INCENTIVE PROGRAM (Part 2):** The Department has allocated \$1500.00 and will match up to \$50.00 toward any members new/unpaid upgrade/reinstatement to convert current or prospective members to joining as a Life Member. Matching funds can be provided by a Post, District, or VFW friendly entity that would partner to reduce membership dues to prospective members. *Installment Plans exempt from eligibility.* 

**POST COMMANDER 102%+ MEMBERSHIP:** State Commander Chris Beaty is recognizing those Post Commanders that lead their Post to 102%+ attaining the National membership goal by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and will receive a VFW Department of Nebraska Ballcap.

**DISTRICT COMMANDER 102%+ MEMBERSHIP:** State Commander Chris Beaty is recognizing those District Commanders whose District attains 102%+ National membership by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 with VFW Department of Nebraska Ballcap and be put into a drawing to win all three recruiter incentive prizes listed below.
