
Service Program Reports

VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION UPDATE

Hello VA Nebraska & Western Iowa Veteran,

We're moving to a safer and more modern online Sign-In experience for Veterans and other beneficiaries who access VA online services (including the My HealtheVet patient portal).

Here's what's changing for VA websites and mobile apps in 2025:

-After January 31, 2025, we'll remove the option to sign in with a My HealtheVet user ID and password.

-After September 30, 2025, we'll remove the option to sign in with a DS Logon username and password. Veterans who don't transition to a modern secure account in time won't lose any stored information. But they'll need to create a **Login.gov** or **ID.me** account to continue to access their information online including secure messaging, online prescription refills, appointment reminders and medical records.

For Veterans who don't want to make this transition, you can still manage your information by phone, mail, or in-person.


