Upon completion of your community engagement events/activities, submit the After-Action form and your Post will receive recognition items.

Note: This is not intended to replace the Community Service Post of the Year or any other established program. However, Posts can use events created for this to include with other programs.

INVOLVE YOUR POST COMMUNITY

You can be the catalyst to get your community involved in commemorating the contributions of all veterans and their family members to our country during the VFW 125th Anniversary year. In addition, it is hoped you will encourage your community to study the history of this era to help ensure a safer and better tomorrow.
