LISTEN CAREFULLY! Find out what benefits they need.

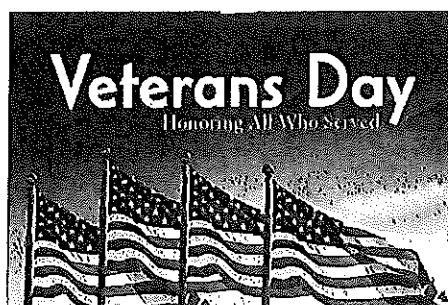
FILL THE VOID! Offer the benefit you feel is most important to them and they will likely join.

Ways to use the "Buddy" Poppy in our program: SCHOLARSHIPS - Include a "Buddy" Poppy when posting scholarship information on a community board. Make a corsage or boutonniere using a "Buddy" Poppy for the Voice Of Democracy and Patriot's Pen winners. VETERANS & FAMILY SUPPORT - Use "Buddy" Poppies as a decoration or centerpiece for any fundraisers you have that support this program. Wrap utensils in a napkin with a "Buddy" Poppy used as a napkin holder. YOUTH ACTIVITIES - Include a "Buddy" Poppy at a holiday parties sponsored by your Post and/or Auxiliary. Your Auxiliary could even create and sponsor a youth art contest featuring the poem "In Flanders Fields."

### A Brief History of Gold Star Wife/Spouses Day

This tradition began in the early part of the 20<sup>th</sup> century as Gold

Star Mother's Day, observed on the last Sunday of September, in 1936. An organization known as Gold Star Wives began operating before the end of the Second World War, and the Gold Star label button tradition was established in the summer of 1947. All of this set the stage for Gold Star Spouses Day, which began as Gold Star Wives Day-the first of which occurred in December 2010. Two years later a Senate resolution codified Gold Star Wives Day, observed on April 5 each year. Later guidance changed the recognition to be more inclusive. Today the event is known as Gold Star Spouses Day, though (as mentioned earlier) many still use "Gold Star Wives Day" interchangeably with Gold Star Spouses Day. The organization Gold Star Wives welcomes all Gold Star spouses, for example, but retains the original name; the organization welcomes membership applications from "Any surviving spouse of any person of the United States military who died while a member of the armed forces of our country, or who died subsequent to such service as a result of an injury or disability incurred during such service."

I have only received reports from 10 Auxiliaries so far. For a complete list and the eligibility requirements go to <http://vfw.org/assistance/financial-grants>. The applicant must be made by the service member, veteran, or eligible dependent. The application is online only. If someone doesn't have a computer or isn't computer savvy offer to meet them at the library or Post Home to help them. If they can't, then offer to go to them with your laptop.



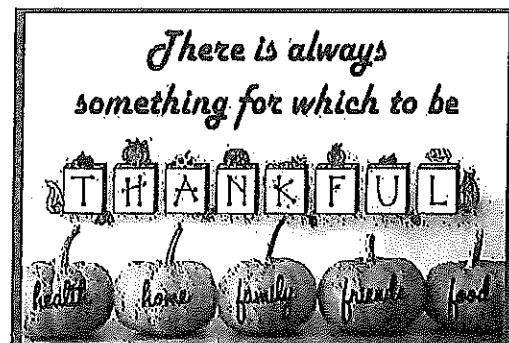
