Question number 6 for the Hospital Year End Report asks: Did you use the Hospital Program Guide? Every Auxiliary will be able to mark yes for this question if they read the Department newsletter. Each month I will cover a section of the guide as we learn the Hospital Program together.

Hospital Volunteers: Any member in good standing can volunteer at a facility in the name of the VFW Auxiliary if that member has been approved by the Auxiliary to do so. Members can volunteer alone or in a group at any hospital.

Sponsored Volunteers: Nonmembers can volunteer under the VFW Auxiliary sponsorship if they are interviewed and screened. The sponsored volunteer is governed by the same ethics and rules prescribed for members.

VFW Auxiliary Hospital Service Pins are awarded by the National Organization. A VFW Auxiliary member in good standing who has volunteered a minimum of 150 hours in any hospital is eligible. Forms for ordering the pins and recognition awards are at www.vfwAuxiliary.org or by contacting the Program Awards Administrator at National Headquarters. I will have some at School of Instruction.

To print forms: Go to the VFW Auxiliary website, click on What We Do, click on Access Auxiliary Program and General Resource, scroll to Hospital, scroll to Application for VFW Auxiliary Hospital Service Pins.

Do this now so the pins can be awarded at a meeting and posted on Facebook. Win-win!


