## MEMBERSHIP & LEADERSHIP

We ended the year at 91.08% in membership. All our officers had their dues paid so we did not lose any officers on any level. As of the writing of this article our membership stands at 91.5%. We only need 596 more members to reach 100%, that's just about 115 members per month. We have 16 Auxiliaries that have reach 100% or better already. When you look at memstats you may not see 16, a few have reached the goal and then lost a member or two. I promised to continue to recognize them as 100%. Our newest Auxiliary to reach 100% is 4688 Imperial. Congratulations. There are 2 Auxiliaries that are at 107%, they are 5820 Ravenna and 5824 Wausa. I would like both of you to drop me a note or call me and let me know how many of your new members are male.

We have a new membership application, please if you are capable of doing so go online and print some and throw the old ones away. I will have some available at Mid-Winter Conference that you can take back to your Auxiliary. So far, this membership year we have 16 new Life, 61 new Annual, and 35 rejoin

members, I know there are more out there, and we need to have the applications to get them signed up.

We had 2 Auxiliaries meet the December 31<sup>st</sup> goal and qualify for the \$25 drawing they are 5136 Lexington and 10727 Bellevue. Great job. Our next goal is for Auxiliaries 201 – 300 members and that deadline is January 31<sup>st</sup>. The Group 5 deadline is the end of February for Auxiliaries with memberships 301 and over. District Presidents you may want to jump in and help your Auxiliaries reach that 100% goal, because the goal for the 100% Districts is the end of March.

Thank you, members, for all that you do. Hope to see many of you in Lincoln.

## CHIEF OF STAFF/EXTENSION

Our #1 goal at this time is to make a plan to get to the members that had not paid as of December 31, 2017. These members are no longer in good standing as of January 1, 2018. A member shall not be in good standing until their dues are paid for the current year. Dues must be paid by June 30 to remain a continuous member. Plan a committee to call, visit, or write these individuals. This is definitely the time to talk to them about a life membership. They will never miss their dues being paid on time again.

Auxiliaries, your delegates and alternates shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held not less than thirty calendar days prior to the District Convention at which District Officers are to be elected. One delegate and one alternate for each fifteen members or fraction thereof in good standing in the Auxiliary at the time of the election of Delegates. The Auxiliary Secretary shall send the names of the Delegates and Alternates to the District Secretary prior to the District Convention. The term of office for which Delegates are elected shall be for one year from date of the election, as described in this Section 303 until the election of new Delegates. Your District President will be receiving the forms that you need to fill out and send your District Secretary at the Mid-Winter Conference in Lincoln.

District Presidents, it is time to think about your Credential Committee for your District Convention.

Auxiliary Members check out the Awards for members in the National Program Book.

#1 Award **Catch the Dream For Our Veterans Keepsake** to one member in each Department who assists in revitalizing his/her Auxiliary and who uses the Healthy Auxiliary materials. Please state why you think they should be nominated and send it to me by March 15, 2018.

#2 Award for Members: Special National President's Coin to one member in each Department who demonstrates the best mentoring in his/her Auxiliary and/or Department. Please send your nomination to me by March 15, 2018.

#1 Award for Auxiliaries: **Catch the Dream for Our Veterans Citation** to one Auxiliary in each Department that best used publicity, i.e. radio/TV/social media, in forming their Auxiliary or revitalizing their Auxiliary. Please state why you think they should be nominated and send it to me by March 15, 2018.

#2 Award for Auxiliaries: Citation to one Auxiliary in each Department that implements the CARE Mentoring Program or some other mentoring program. Please send to me by March 15, 2018.

Looking forward to seeing everyone at Mid-Winter Conference in Lincoln the first weekend in February. Our National President Dee Guillory will be with us. Come out and meet her, she is a great lady.

### GOLD STAR/CHAPLAIN

There are many organizations or shelters that accept winter clothing, so consider donating your gently used or even new items to them. We must Stay on Course for Our Veterans all year long.

This month's Gold Star story was submitted by Beryl Knotwell.

"My brother, Kenneth Hamilton was born December 23, 1919. Kenneth was killed in action on August 16, 1944. When he graduated high school in 1938, jobs were scarce so he joined the Cavalry in Fort Riley, Kansas. At this time, it was a horse cavalry and later became mechanized cavalry. Kenneth was sent down to the U.S. border along the Rio Grande where he rode around in a jeep to patrol that area. At one time he was also stationed somewhere in the state of Washington. When Kenneth decided he would like to become an officer, he switched from cavalry to the infantry as there were no openings in the cavalry. After training, he came out as a 2nd lieutenant. By this time we were fully engaged in war.

Kenneth was given a two week leave before going overseas, so he spent time in McCook, Nebraska with his parents and me. I was working at the McCook Army Air Base as a CF2 clerical/stenographer at the Flight Surgeons office in the base hospital unit. There were always Saturday night dances at the base, so I took my brother there one Saturday night, where he really enjoyed meeting the medical personnel that I knew and worked with.

That was the last time I saw him. He was sent to Bougainville in the South Pacific where he was in charge of his troops. One morning after prayer service, Kenneth was crossing paths from one of his troops to another, and as he crossed the path, a Japanese soldier in the trees shot him. He is buried in the McCook Cemetery.

My sister Lenora was a lieutenant in the Army Nurse Corps in

California, and my brother Dean was in the U.S. Navy. Both of them wanted to be transferred to an overseas camp, but because of losing their brother in the war, they were not able to."

Thank you Beryl for sharing your story.

In closing, I would like to say a short prayer: Dear Lord, we ask you to watch over and give comfort to all Gold Star members. May they know that our Auxiliary and our nation will forever be grateful for the ultimate sacrifice their family has paid. AMEN

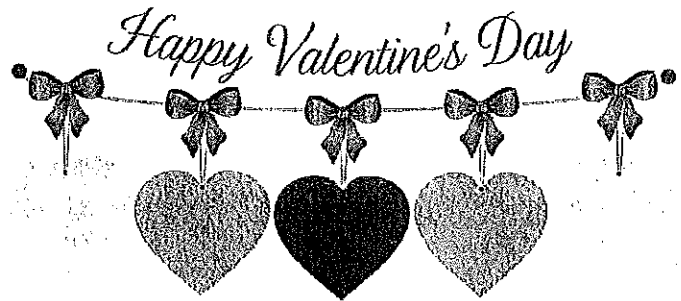
