Comrades,

Greetings and welcome to the 2017/18 Membership year. I only have two primary goals – taking care of veterans and taking care of membership. It is impossible to do the first if you don't have the second!

First, the state membership team stands ready to assist you with new member recruiting events and reinstate/dues membership drives with recruiting literature and manpower.

Second, we have an actual membership recruiting plan full of ideas on how and where to recruit and get new and reinstated members as well as proven methodology on conduction dues drives.

Third, we have a host of membership Augmentees assigned to over half the posts in the state to assist with obtaining 100%. These comrades are Line Officers, District Commanders, Past Department Commanders, and past District Commanders. I would ask that when they show up at your post you extend them the same courtesy you would me.

Lastly, we have a membership incentive program. Nearly all of this is outlined in the State Membership Recruiting and Incentive Program. But we have one new item – for each post

that obtains 100% membership and has one or more new or reinstated member by December 31st, we will award an Early Bird 100%/Recruiting Certificate and a \$100 stipend for a post representative to come to Winter Conference to personally accept the Certificate. If accomplished by January 31st, stipend will be \$50.

Why are we doing all this? National membership has been declining for 25 years – a quarter of a century! Except for a couple of those years, so has the membership in our state. We are down from over 20,000 a few years ago to about 16,000. This is a trend we must break if we are to continue to help veterans. The smaller our membership, the fewer posts, and the less money we have, means the fewer veterans and less help we can provide each. Please help me help all veterans in our state. The harder we work membership, the more comrades we have, the more we can do for our veterans.

10. ALL DISTRICT COMMANDERS ARE REMINDED THAT NOTICE of **District Meetings should be at Department Headquarters at least 30 days prior to meeting date** so that the representative requested can be scheduled, if possible; and **all requests for Department Representatives at any post or district function must be made through Department Headquarters.**

11. All checks payable to Department Headquarters should be made payable to: VFW Department of Nebraska, not an individual.

12. Please mail any change of address to Department Headquarters, 2431 N. 48<sup>th</sup> St., Lincoln, NE 68504 or email to [johnl@vfwne.org](mailto:johnl@vfwne.org) so our records can be corrected, changed and sent to National Headquarters.

13. Post Quartermasters are urged to make sure that all money due Department Headquarters is paid currently. CAUTION: Please, make sure the amount is correct to avoid returning the check; also, that all necessary signatures are on the check.

14. All posts are expected and mandated by the National Constitution and By-Laws to audit the post books every three months; June 30, September 30, December 31, and March 31. The audit reports are due prior to the 30th of the following month.

15. All Post and District Commanders are urged to appoint their key Chairmen as soon as possible, if not done at this time, and notify Department Headquarters, as many District Chairmen may be on Department Committees and possibly Post Chairmen may be on District Committees.

16. **All Post Commanders and District Commanders** are urged and requested to keep the records pertaining to them. The All-State and All-American Post "20 Questions" found in the State Program book, needs to be returned to Department by November 1, 2017 (for 10 Points) or by January 16, 2018 (for 5 points) towards the white hat awards.

17. All Posts are reminded that they must register at least one member for the National Convention, according to National By-Laws (Section 222 /d). Cost \$25.00 prior to National Convention. Failure to comply may result in suspension of Post charter by National VFW Commander according to National By-Laws (Section 211).

18. All Posts requesting speakers or representatives must request same through the Department 30 days in advance of such occasion, in order to avoid confusion of Representative assignments.

19. Membership: When dues are paid at the Post, Quartermasters must ensure that **\$34.00** of the dues money is sent to National and National will forward Department dues to the Department.

20. Attention of Post Commander to Section 218 /k of the Manual of Procedure which states, "He or his representative shall attend all properly called District Conventions or District Meetings. Failure without just cause to perform this duty may result in removal from office."

21. VFW Posts operating clubs or canteens are hereby notified that operation of such clubs or canteens will be closed during regular or special Post meetings and that no alcoholic beverages will be allowed during any meetings of any type in the meeting room, be it post, District, or Department meeting.

22. Attention is directed to the Budget Advisory Committee. The Chairman shall be the one-year member and the 2017-2018 Chairman is Sam DeJohn.

23. The Chairman of the Budget Advisory Committee shall notify the Department Commander, Department Quartermaster and other Budget Advisory Committee members of dates that are set for the meetings.

24. Officer Proof of Eligibility Requirements: All Posts and Districts are reminded that in accordance with the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure that officers, elected and appointed, shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until such proof of eligibility has been submitted to respective Adjutant for review and filing.

25. National By-Laws provides for only one type of membership: **active membership**. There are no provisions in the National By-Laws nor is there any authority or justification for issuance of Club Membership cards, Associate Member cards, Honorary Membership cards, Courtesy Membership cards or any other special type of cards. Any Post issuing such unauthorized cards, or conducting club operations open to the general public, endangers its standing with the Internal Revenue Service as a nonprofit organization.

Officers signing outlaw cards admitting nonmembers to VFW premises are subject to disciplinary action. National and Department officers cannot defend practices that conflict with VFW By-Laws or Manual of Procedure.

26. The attention of all units is called to Section 1101 of the By-Laws and Manual of Procedure which provides for the formation and control of the Auxiliary. This section provides that the Auxiliary shall be under the control of the corresponding unit of the Veterans of Foreign Wars but shall be permitted to function in accordance with the National, and Department By-Laws and Rules and Regulations of the Auxiliary.

In addition to provisions of Auxiliary By-laws, solicitation of funds or donations to auxiliary units, including contracts with fund-raising organizations for greeting cards, calendars and/or label programs shall be subject to approval and ratification by the governing body of the corresponding unit of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.


27. Only the official hat of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States shall be worn at Post, District, and Department meetings. All others shall be removed during official meetings.

28. All Commanders are reminded that Section 709, Manual of Procedure - Control of Units, requires that any activity, unit or club sponsored, conducted or operated by, for or in behalf of a Post, County Council, District or Department shall be at all times under the direct control of such Post, County Council, District or Department and that all money, property or assets of any kind must be placed in the care and custody of the respective Quartermaster. All Commanders should ensure that all provisions of Section 709 are enforced.

Commander Larry Gerlt distributed his Commander's pin and discussed the requirements for all state and all American.


Motion was made by Sam DeJohn to approve the budget for 2017-2018. Seconded by Dione Gorji. Motion passed unanimously.
