- Membership greater than 100%
- Finish in top 25 posts in your division that meet all the following criteria
 - Voice of Democracy minimum of one entry advanced to District judging (Any Post can donate \$75 to National in lieu of entry)
 - Patriots Pen minimum of one entry advanced to District judging (Any Post can donate \$75 to National in lieu of entry**see last page)
 - National Citizenship Education Teachers Award submit an entry in all three categories (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) advanced to District judging (Any Post can donate \$75 to National in lieu of each entry
 - o Buddy Poppy- must purchase Buddy Poppies
 - Hold a fundraiser with the proceeds going to Veterans & Military
 Support Programs Services, minimum of \$100
 - o National Veterans Service Appoint a Post service officer
- **Deadline for VOD, PP and Teacher of the Year submissions and donations in lieu of submissions, will coincide with the Posts' entry deadline of midnight October 31st
 2019. Donations after the deadline will not be accepted for participation credit.
- **Donations made to replace a Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen, National Citizenship Education Teachers Award and towards Veterans & Military Support Programs Services as listed above will only be accepted through the following link. ALL STATE CRITERIA: This criteria applies to BOTH the Post Commander and Quartermaster. There will be 22 possible white hat winners. (11 Cmdrs. & 11 QMs) The items in red are required items.

Post MUST be 100%, or above, in membership by June 30th, 2020.
 (Post MUST have over 25 members and have at least 1 new or reinstated member)

One extra point will be given for each percentage, or portion thereof, over the 100% level.

- Post Commanders and Quartermasters MUST submit the completed Twenty (20) Questions from this
 program book. Ten (10) points will be awarded if completed and received at Dept. HQ by Nov. 1st,
 2019. Five (5) points will be awarded if completed and received at Dept. HQ by Jan. 16th, 2020.
