Conference Attendees,

On January 14<sup>th</sup>, the Lincoln Health Director Pat Lopez issued a Directed Health Measure (DHM) instituting a requirement that “all individuals ages two and older – regardless of vaccination status – wear a mask when they are in an indoor space unless six feet of separation from others at all times can be achieved.” The DHM is not set to expire until February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and therefore will be in effect during the VFW’s Mid-winter Conference.

Although there are many different positions on mask mandates, directed health measures, and COVID-19 in general – there is one thing that all of us can agree on and that is that the Veterans of Foreign Wars is the greatest veteran’s organization, and NO ONE DOES MORE FOR VETERANS. As an organization, we intend to move forward with the planned Mid-Winter Conference, and it is imperative that those who are able to attend the conference understand that there will be an expectation that members of the VFW and it’s Auxiliary will follow the Directed Health Measure and any other guidelines outlined by the Graduate Hotel and their staff.

Although these DHM’s may be inconvenient or perceived by some as unnecessary, there is high confidence that the VFW will be able to conduct the business of the organization and continue the mission of serving Nebraska’s veterans and their families.

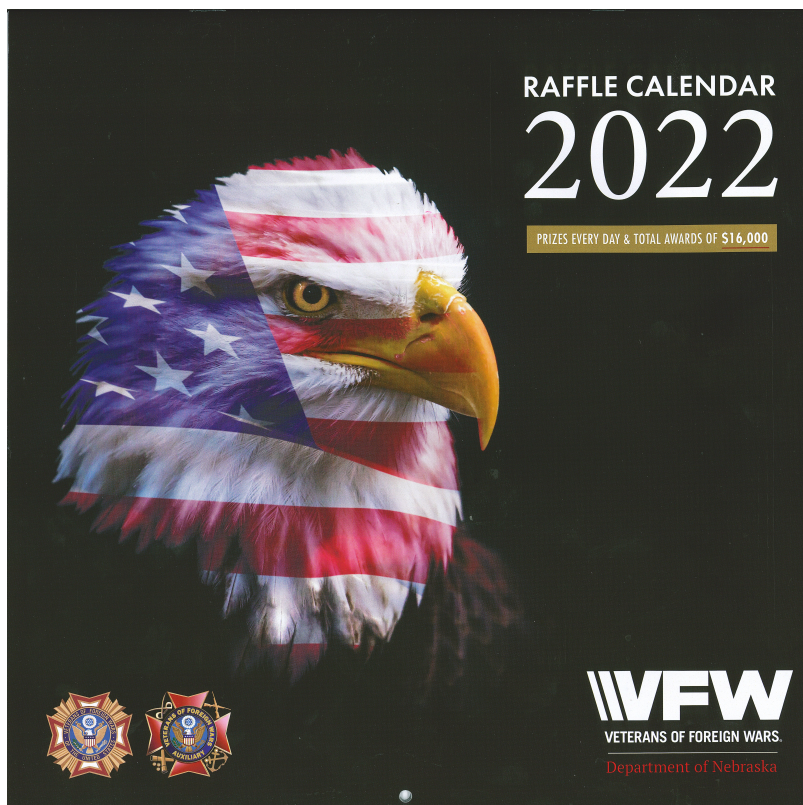
