

Membership – Where do we stand, what do we need.

As of 19 January, we are second place in the Big Ten Conference and eighth nationally with 91.83%! This is due to the efforts of the membership team (Line Officers, District Commanders, Past State Commanders, Offutt Recruiting Team, and two volunteers) and your efforts. We have our best shot in a decade of being an All American Department. BUT, this isn't a lock. We still need 1362 more members to renew or be recruited to do it. Our membership team is here to help – to advise and assist you.



We need all hands on deck (and I'm not even Navy) to get the job done. Post Leadership (Commander, QM, Membership Chair) needs to ensure dues are collected from all annual "subscription" dues members.
